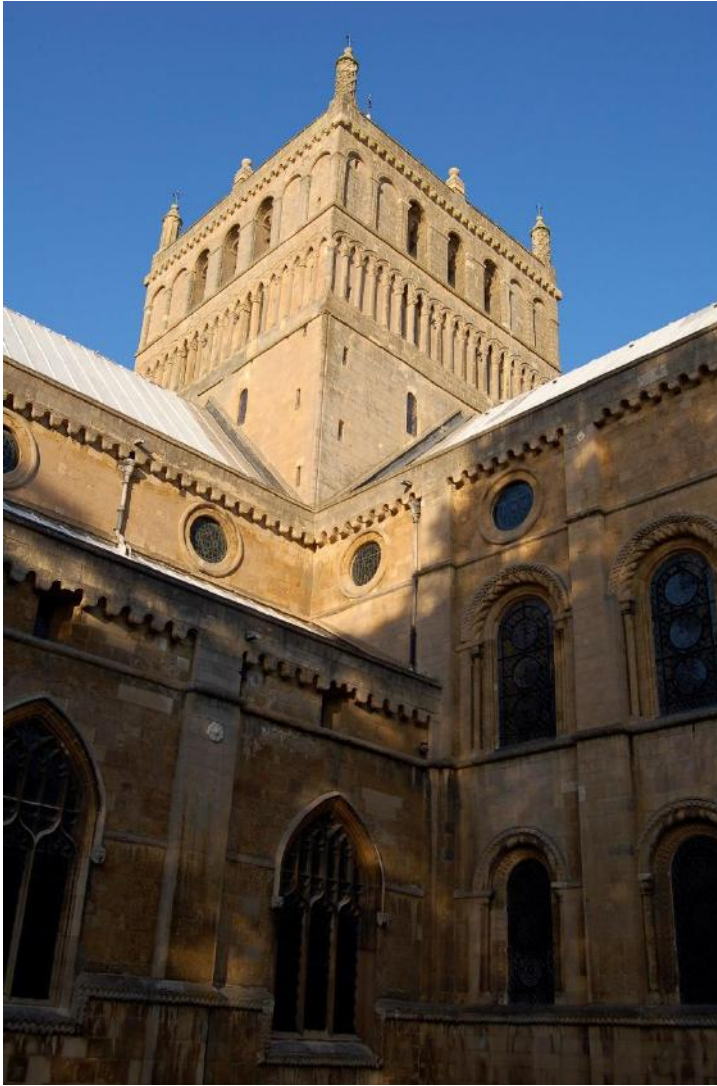


I'm going to

is very big.



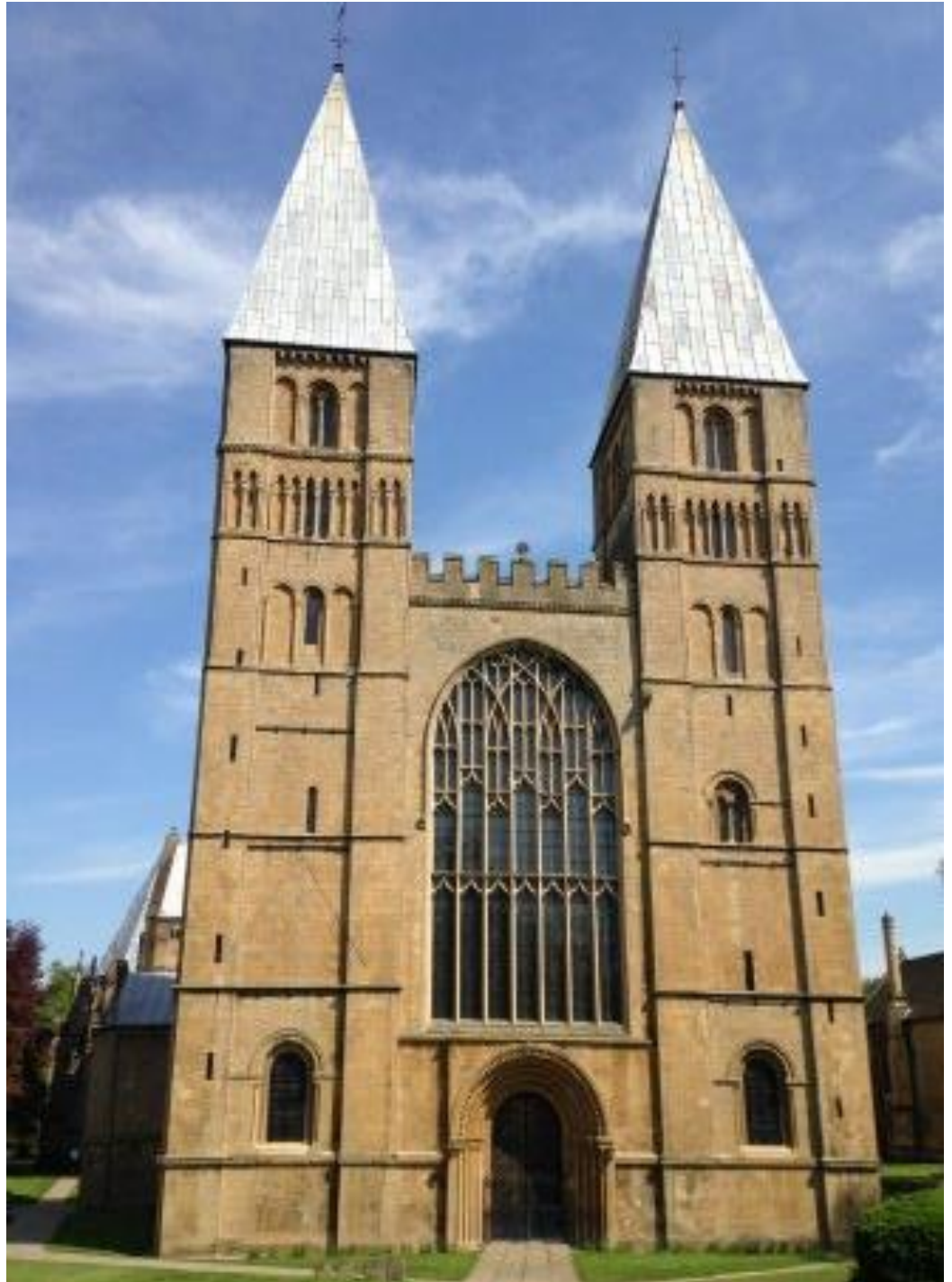
In the tower there are bells which chime every quarter of an hour.

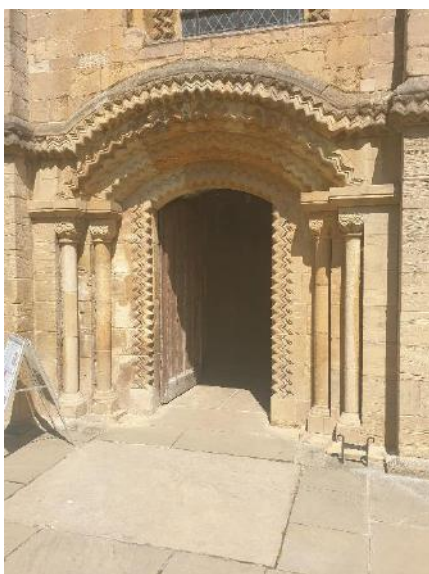
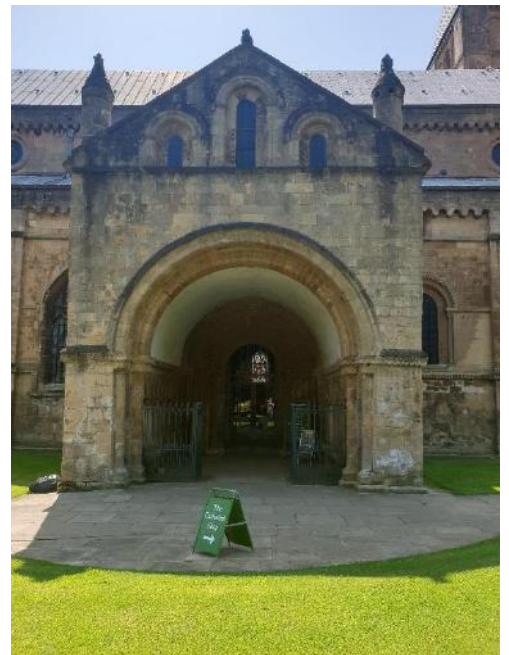


I will enter through one of these doors.



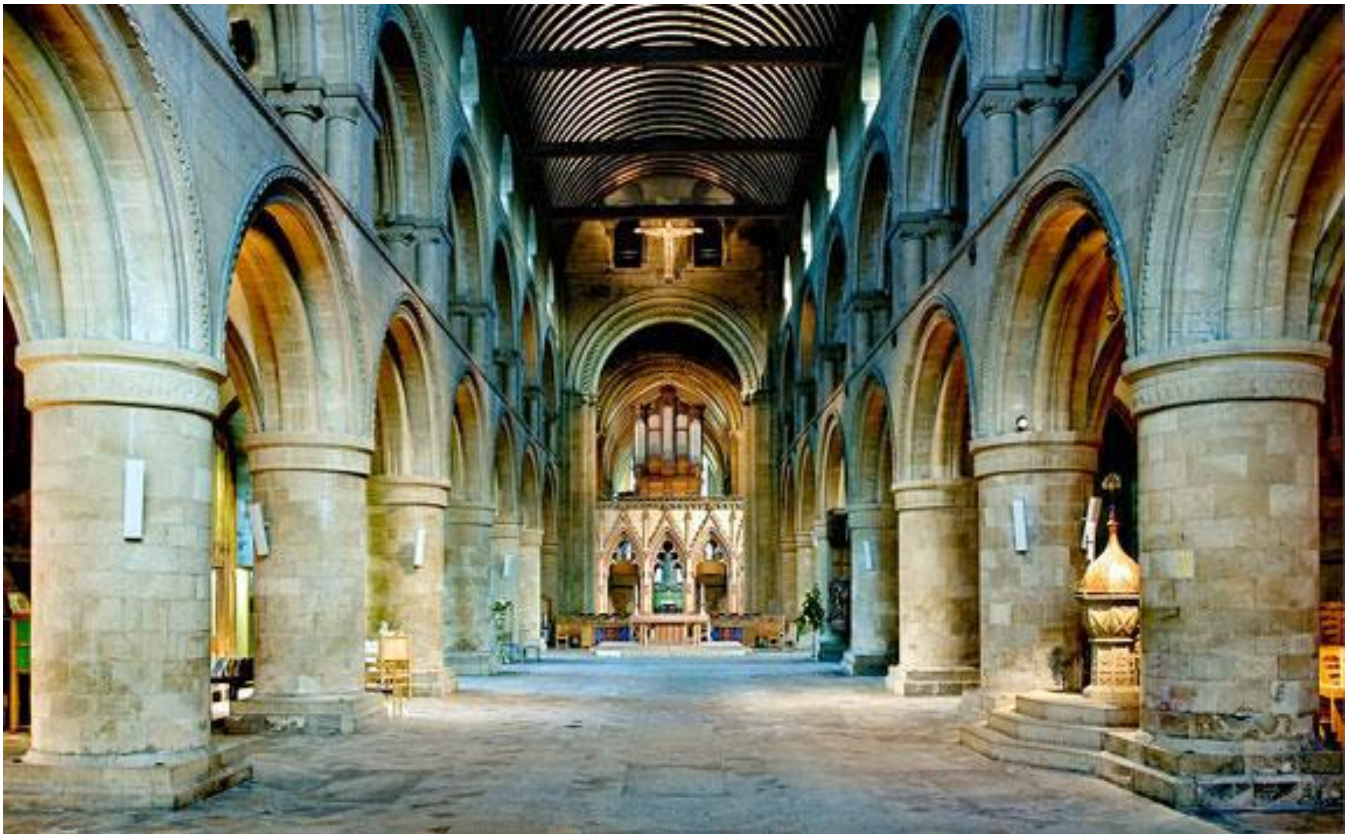
The West Door

In the Clergy Vestry I can close the door and the lights can be turned off.



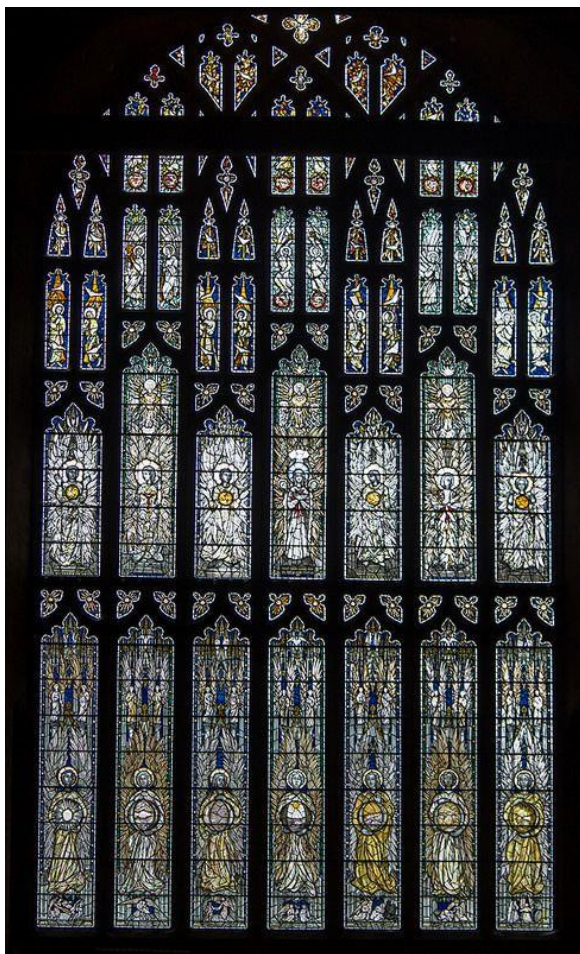


The Candle Chapel is a small space. I can sit quietly and look at the candles.
