Important note: safeguarding training must be completed every 3 years before the course expiry date so that the level of requisite training held is without a break.

- 3 yearly renewal: Basic awareness/Foundation/Leadership/Senior Leadership: renew to the highest level course you hold (note: the lower-level courses must all have been completed once, as they are prerequisites for the higher-level courses).
- 3 yearly renewal: Domestic Abuse Awareness/Safer Recruitment: if a requirement of your role.

- 2. Click on create a new account.

Username (lower case only)

Password (needs to have at least one capital letter and a number)

You will need an email address.

Please answer the questions required as follows:

Your role: e.g. Volunteer/Steward/Sidesperson/Administrator etc.

You should then receive an email which gives a link to click on to get you back to the site to start the training. You should then also be able to log in and out as you wish using your username and password.
